

GULL SPREADS ITS WINGS OVER CHRISTCHURCH

Gull Opens third Christchurch site in South Hagley as it looks to expand in South Island

Gull New Zealand says it has launched its third site in Christchurch at South Hagley as part of expanding its service to Christchurch and South Island motorists.

Gull's General Manager, Dave Bodger says the new Gull site opposite South Hagley Park on the corner of Moorehouse Avenue and Lincoln Road in Christchurch is in a prime site to deliver ongoing savings and the "Gull effect" to the Canterbury region.

The "Gull effect", a term coined by the New Zealand Automobile Association (AA), results in localised price drops across the board and delivers savings directly back to the community. Bodger adds that Gull's third site in Christchurch will provide additional competition and lower prices for South Island motorists.

"This can only be a good thing as Cantabrians get back in work, school and travel. Lincoln and Moorehouse is a prime location in Christchurch and was previously a service station for the oil majors. Gull has transformed the site and as our third in Christchurch and fifth in the South Island we are very pleased with progress.
